- To assist with key school events, including parent and public functions, such as productions or extra-curricular events, opening evenings /days etc.
- To help with the effective running of the school, as directed by staff
- To represent the views and opinions of your Year Group in Student Council meetings

- Good organisation skills and a sense of responsibility
- Good communication skills
- Can-do attitude
- Creative thinking

The selection process involves:

- A written application: submit to Roberta at the main reception by Thursday 27 October (end of break)
- A short interview with a Head of Year and member of the Senior Leadership Team after half term
